Dear Parent/Carer,

As the dark nights are creeping in and extra lights are making an appearance in each of our homes, we are reminded that Christmas is just around the corner. As many of you know, December is a very busy month in MPS and we have a number of activities planned for all the family to enjoy. We are also very aware that with the busyness of this period, it's difficult to keep on track of all that is going on, so below is a list of important dates/events for your diary.

School Concert – Wednesday 6th December

After the success of last year's performance, we have decided to continue to offer a morning performance at 10:30am and an evening performance starting at 6:30pm in Mountnorris Presbyterian Church Hall. Each class will be performing either a song, dance, poem or short sketch and we look forward to watching our talented pupils on stage. Tickets are £5 per person (consider it as a voluntary donation) and these can be purchased using the 'School Money' app or by contacting Mrs Anderson in the school office. At this stage, we are limiting it to 3 tickets per family and would kindly ask that you attend either the morning or the evening performance, to ensure that every family has the opportunity to see their child on stage. The online system will open on Monday 27th November at 10am and will close on Friday 1st December at 12noon. Any remaining tickets will be sold from 9:30am on Monday 5th December, on a first come first served basis, by contacting Mrs Anderson in the school office.

On the morning of the performance, pupils should be left to school, as normal, and class teachers will walk them down to the church hall at 9:30am. Pupils will not need their school bags, only a snack for during the interval. After the performance, pupils can go home early at 12noon, but should be collected at the church hall rather than at the school. For any pupils remaining in school, staff will walk them back up to school and normal home time arrangements will still be in place, however, there will be no after school clubs on that day. School dinners will be available for any pupils staying in school. In preparation for the evening performance, we would kindly ask that pupils be at the church hall for 5:45pm.

The Parent Support Group will be selling drinks, crisps and snacks during the interval at both performances and it would be greatly appreciated if you could support this as all money raised will be used to purchase new school resources.

An Afternoon of Christmas Joy – Saturday 9th December

The Parent Support Group are organising a Christmas afternoon for all the family to enjoy, in the school playground, from 12noon — 3pm. There will be a nativity scene, Christmas sing-a-long, facepainting and stalls to make Reindeer food and write a Christmas wish. Families can also pay to get their photograph taken with Santa and hot drinks, hotdogs and snacks can be purchased throughout the afternoon to keep you warm. Christmas Pantomime – Monday 11th or Thursday 14th December

Pupils in **Reception-P4** will go to the Marketplace Theatre, Armagh, on Monday 11th December. They will have an early lunch at 11:45am and will leave school at 12:15pm. Pupils should wear full school uniform, including a coat, and they can bring their water bottle with them as a small snack will be provided by the school during the interval. We will be returning to school for 4pm and pupils can be collected from their class teacher at the back playground gate. Home times may change due to circumstances beyond our control so keep an eye on the school app for any updates/notifications.

Pupils in **P5-7** will be travelling to the Grand Opera House, Belfast, on Thursday 14th December. We will be leaving school at 11am. Pupils should wear full school uniform, including a coat, as well as bringing a packed lunch. A small snack will be provided by the school for pupils to eat during the interval. We will be returning to school for 5pm and pupils can be collected from their class teacher at the back playground date. Home times may change due to circumstances beyond our control so keep an eye on the school app for any updates/notifications.

Christmas Dinner in School – Wednesday 13th December

The Christmas dinner for pupils will be on Wednesday 13th December and this can be booked and paid for using the 'School Money' app. We would kindly ask that this is booked by Monday 11th December, to allow the kitchen staff time to prepare for the big day. Pupils can wear a Christmas Jumper and accessories on the day as we will be completing the 'Santa Daily Mile' walk in the morning and after lunch they can relax and watch a Christmas movie.
